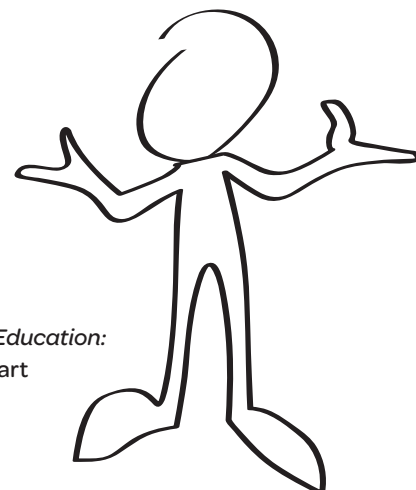


Earn Well
