What You Learned

Talk about It

Ask your parents:

- What would you like me to know about lending?

Do It

- With your parents, talk about a time when you borrowed something well and returned it on time or early.
- Ask your parents what qualities they want you to have to borrow well.
- Keep track of what you borrow and what you lend. Make a list. Write what you borrowed (or lent). Name the item, the person you borrowed it from (or lent it to), the date you borrowed it (or lent it), and the date you will give it back (or expect it back).
