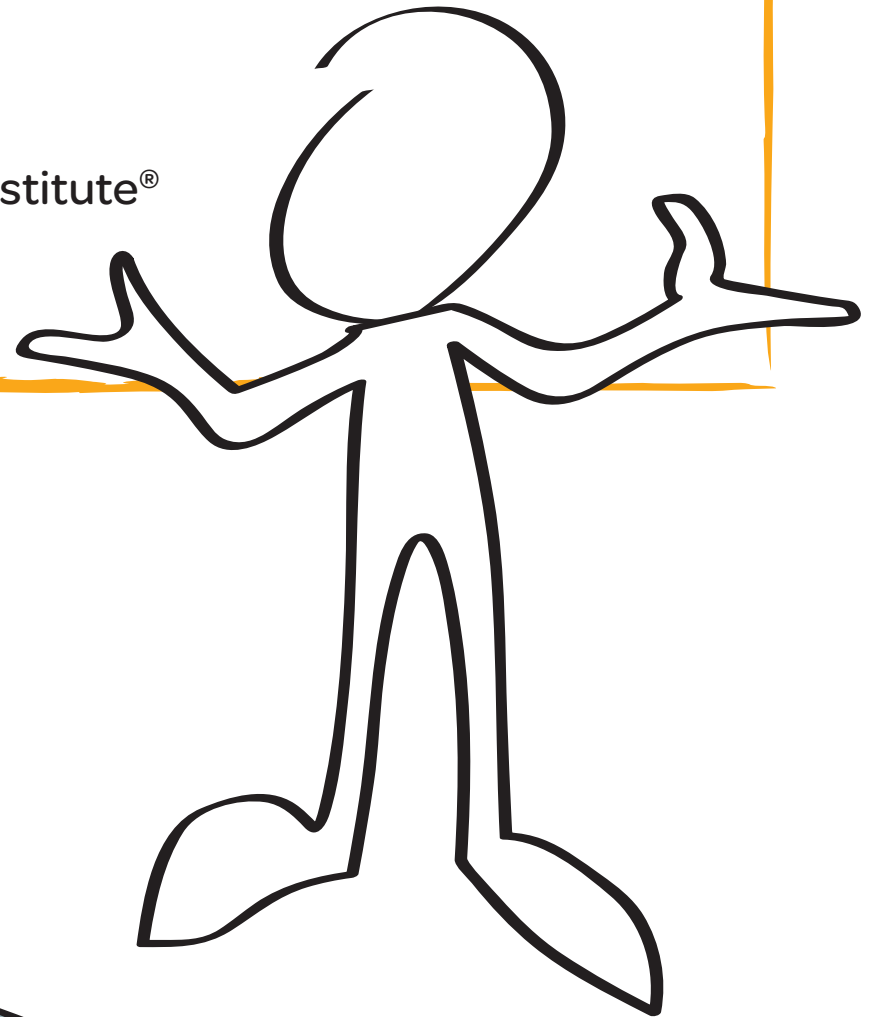

Review and Evaluate

How do parents influence young people's giving?

1. When one parent volunteers, a young person is twice as likely to volunteer than a young person who has no family members who volunteer.
2. When one parent volunteers, a young person is three times as likely to volunteer on a regular basis than a young person who has no family members who volunteer.
