(starting at age 11)

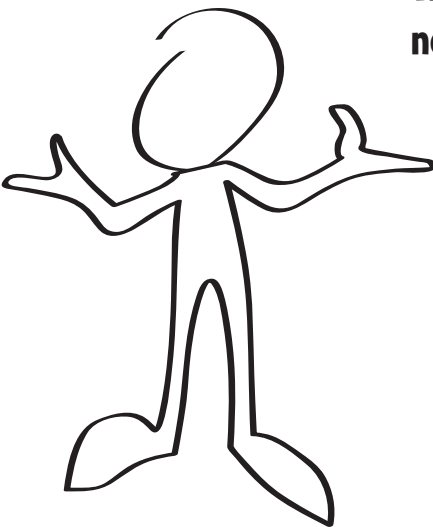
Get a paper route (starting at
